Practical

Introduction to the lift truck to be used for training and manoeuvring, stacking, de-stacking, previously declared and identified weaknesses, remedial tuition and practice of the course contents.

Testing

A Practical test of basic operating skills will be conducted. Completion of Pre-use checks, in accordance with the manufacturers guidelines. Concluding with, associated knowledge examination*.
