Funding available in Leeds, Barnsley, Wakefield, Harrogate, York, Craven, Kirklees, Calderdale and Selby...

The Response project is an ESF initiative led by Leeds City College and funded via the Skills Support for the Workforce programme.

National Safety Training is a specialist training provider working on this response project.

This funding stream aims to support employers across the Leeds City Region. The Response project will work with Small and Medium Enterprises and their employees, delivering free training, support, and bespoke interventions.

Eligibility:

- Individuals must be employed within a small or medium enterprise (SME) with fewer than 250 employees.
- Employers must be based within the Leeds City Region (Bradford, Calderdale, Kirklees, Leeds, Wakefield, Craven, Harrogate, York, Selby and Barnsley)
- Individuals must be aged 19+
- Training must be non-mandatory and accredited
- Training can be delivered at Level 2 and Level 3
