

Warehousing and Storage Skills

Course Duration

This depends on individual circumstances and experience, but most apprentices will complete the framework within 12 months

Entry Requirements:

Applicants must be willing to work shifts, as part of a team and be good timekeepers. Employers are also interested in applicants who have basic literacy and numeracy skills on which this Apprenticeship will build. Candidates can start work in Warehousing at 16, but to drive a forklift truck unsupervised candidates must be at least 18. Training can be undertaken before then, but work must be supervised until candidates are 18. The candidate's job role and range of activities will need to meet the qualification requirements.

The Apprenticeship (Level 2) comprises of:

1. Competence Based Element - Level 2 Certificate in Warehousing and Storage. This is a combined qualification incorporating competence and knowledge, which is separately assessed.
2. Functional Skills - Communication Level 1, or Key Skills – Communication Level 1 and Application of Number Level 1, or Key Skills – Application of Number level 1
3. Employee Rights and Responsibilities in the Logistics Industry

Objective

The aim of this Intermediate Apprenticeship is to provide the Warehousing Industry with staff who have the knowledge, skills and confidence to help their businesses grow and to provide a career path for Apprentices to higher level jobs and qualifications.

Warehouse operatives, depending on the size of the company, can undertake a range of duties, working alone or in a team, including loading/unloading of vehicles and selecting and packing customer orders, ensuring goods are ready for dispatch on time

For an Apprentice to be able to enroll onto this program they must be in employment with an employer working in the sector.

Not in employment?

Progression

After completion of the Intermediate Apprenticeship in Warehousing and Storage, progression to the following Advanced Apprenticeships is possible:

- Logistics Operations Advanced Apprenticeship

There are also opportunities to move into Level 3 (supervisory) jobs and training such as Traffic Office Manager, Warehouse Manager, and Transport Manager
